



Ukraine Should Be Neutralized to Prevent a “World War”

A Flashpoint in Ukraine Can Grow into a Global Crisis

The international community observes the current situation that Russia is to be blamed one-sidedly and Ukraine is the victim. However, this crisis is a faux pas created by President Zelenskyy, who has little understanding of Russia’s standpoint and tried to join NATO and EU.

It’s Important to Understand Russia’s Standpoint

Since the end of the Cold War, NATO – the military alliance of Europe – expanded eastward. On the other hand, Russia has been protesting against NATO’s eastward expansion as the threat to Russia’s national security. Especially from the geopolitical point of view, Ukraine is Russia’s buffer zone with European nations. Russia could defend itself from the invasions by Napoleon and Hitler thanks to the existence of Ukraine as its buffer zone.

It was foreseeable that Russia would take countermeasures, if Ukraine approached the Western nations rapidly.

Also, President Putin intended to protect pro-Russian people from persecution by anti-Russian forces through this special operation in Ukraine.

Japan Has Involved Itself into This Crisis Too Much

Following the Western nations, Japan has voted to condemn Russia at its parliament, imposed an economic sanction on Russia, and provided bullet-proof vests to Ukraine. However, this is “military aid.” We cannot help but say that Japan has stepped into this crisis too much.

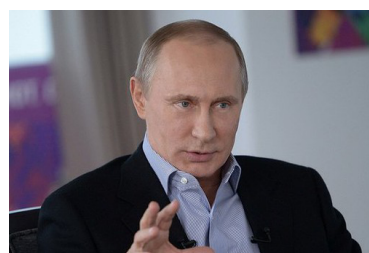

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Japan Has to Build a China Encircling Network, Instead of Turning Against Russia

Neutralize Ukraine Through Japan's Original Diplomacy

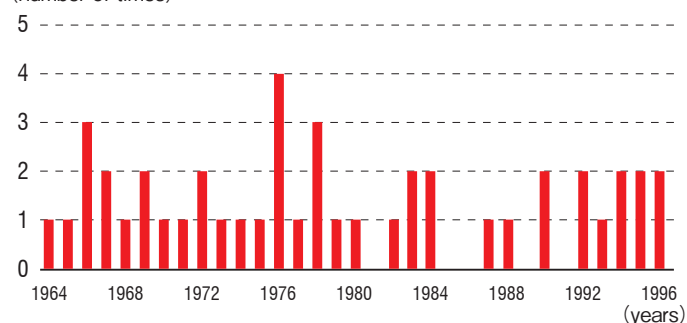

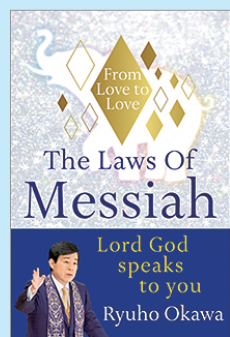
For current Japan and the world, the true threat is China. China has been intruding Japanese territorial waters near the Senkaku Islands and airspace repeatedly. It also deploys missiles, targeting Japan. Moreover, China has taken control of Uyghur, Tibet and South Mongolia, which have different languages and cultures, as "autonomous regions". There have been severe human rights violations including tortures, slaughters, or nuclear tests in the areas.

If Japan corners Russia, it will have no choice but to team up with China and North Korea in order to confront the Western nations and Japan. In that case, there can be the worst scenario: Japan will have to fight against China and Russia simultaneously.

Enforce Japan-Russia Relation for Japanese National Interest

President Putin is a devout person, who has revived the Russian Orthodox Church. On the other hand, China is an "atheistic and materialistic nation", and is conducting brutal politics and human rights violation without hesitation. We have to understand that Russia's action and China's hegemonic expansion are fundamentally different.

From the viewpoints of the formation of the China encirclement network as well as the energy security, it is obviously more in line with Japan's national interest to strengthen its friendly relation with Russia.
